A total of **135 PQs** were asked. The Ministry of Education received the most PQs.


MPs made **598 budget cuts** across seven days of Committee of Supply.

Did you know?


This chart shows average attendance across all sittings in the month based on the Parliamentary Reports, which track attendance at roll call.

However, MPs who are there at roll call may not be there throughout the entire Parliamentary session.


Some photos or videos show that Parliament can be largely empty during less important debates.






